- 3. The study utilized a quantitative research approach and a random convenience sample strategy to examine the function of social workers in determining community participation and satisfaction that leads to the achievement of life goals. The study was limited to 20 rural communities/areas in two Indonesian provinces, namely South Kalimantan and Banjarmasin. The researchers utilized data collectors who were indigenous to these rural communities to locate low-income families and solicit their participation in the study. - 5. In the discussion section, the study must highlight the importance of providing rural communities with employment opportunities and necessities to improve their living standards and well-being. There is also a need to extend the theoretical implications of the study.

Reviewer 2

- I. The authors should highlight the significance of community participation in various programs undertaken by social workers, which can encourage rural residents to work hard to better their living conditions. They should also emphasize the need for rural development planning to integrate rural sectors more equitably and efficiently.
- II. The author hypothesized that social workers' attributes such as rural familiarity, social connections, and place integration positively influence the fulfillment of life aspirations in rural communities. However, they should support their arguments with adequate literature from past studies.
- III. The study must highlight the importance of providing rural communities with employment opportunities and necessities to improve their living standards and well-being. The theoretical implications of the study must include the development of a framework to examine the elements influencing the achievement of life goals among rural communities and the significance of rural community participation and satisfaction in achieving life goals.
